## CIRCULAR

In terms of the letter of the Medical Council of India No.MCI-211(2)/2014-Ethics/100305 dated 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2014, in pursuance to the Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP (Civil) No.235/2012 titled as Save Life Foundation & ANR Vs. Union of India & ANR, an advisory and instruction are issued to all the doctors registered and/or working in the NCT of Delhi to ensure that in case of emergency situation pertaining to the road accidents or any other emergent situation, doctors should attend the patients and give them emergency treatment immediately failing which, the State Medical Council and/or Medical Council of India may take appropriate action against the erring doctors under the provisions and Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct Etiquette and Ethics) Regulation, 2002.
