### 1. Minutes of the meeting held on 23rd September, 2021.

The minutes of the Council meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2021 were circulated to all the members present, for information.

### 2. Action taken report of minutes of the meeting held on 23rd September, 2021.

Action taken reports, which were circulated to all the members present, were approved. The same are appended herewith as **Annexure 'A'**.

### 3. To discuss cases of medical negligence and unethical conduct.

(a) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No. 3323-a representation from Police Station PP AIIMS, P.S. Hauz Khas, South Distt, Delhi, seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Shri Ranjit Kumar, Sadarpur, Sector 45 Noida, Gautam Budh Nagar, Uttar Pradesh, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi-110029, in the treatment administered to complainant's son Master Saurabh Kumar, resulting in his death, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

Dr. Maneesh Singhal recused himself from the proceedings.

- (b) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3226 of Shri Rahul Sanghi, r/o-G-1/56, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Uttam Nagar, Near Metro Pillar no: 674, New Delhi-110059, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Rajiv Sethi of Mata Roop Rani Maggo Hospital, C-8/9, Om Vihar, Phase-1, Uttam Nagar, West Delhi, Opposite Metro Pillar No.709, New Delhi-110059, in the preparation/examination of ultrasound report of the complainant's wife Smt Sonam, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (c) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2891 of Shri Shailesh Jain, 76, Nimri Colony, Ashok Vihar, Phase IV, Delhi-110052, alleging medical negligence a on the part of doctors of Saroj Medical Institute, Jai Road, Delhi and Saroj Hospital, Madhubhan Chowk, Delhi, in the treatment administered to complainant's father Shri. Gianendra Jain was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

- (d) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3127 of Shri Krishan Lal r/o WZ-47, Ground Floor, Gali No. 14, Krishna Puri, New Delhi-110018, forwarded by Directorate General of Health Services Nursing Homes Cell, alleging medical negligence on the part of Venkateshwar Hospital, Dwarka, New Delhi and Aakash Hospital, Dwarka, New Delhi, in the treatment of complainant's wife Smt. Sheela Devi, resulting in her death on 06.6.2020, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (e) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2803-a representation from Police Station, Najafgarh, New Delhi, seeking medical opinion in respect of death of Smt. Kiran w/o Shri. Roop Singh, allegedly due to medical negligence in the treatment administered to Smt. Kiran at Vikas Hospital, 1629-H, Thana Road, Najafgarh, Delhi-110043, resulting in her death at Deen Dayal Upadhyay Hospital on 28.12.2014, where she was subsequently treated, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (f) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3148 of Shri Sujan Dasgupta, 160 Uttarakhand, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Campus, New Delhi-110067, alleging medical negligence and professional misconduct on the part of Dr. Sawan Bopanna and Fortis Flt. Rajan Dhall Hospital, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi-110070, in the treatment of complainant's wife Smt Tapati Dasgupta resulting in her death on 17.06.2020 at Human Care Medical Charitable Trust (Manipal Hospital, Dwarka) where she subsequently received treatment, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (g) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2592- a representation from the police, seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Shri Naveen Gupta s/o Shri Ram Prakash Gupta r/o Z-87 Dayalsar Road Uttam Nagar New Delhi, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Meera Gupta of Gupta Nursing Home in the treatment of complainant's wife Deepika and her new born baby, resulting in death of new born baby, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (h) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3088 of Shri Manoj Kumar, r/o-D-196, Gokul Puri, Delhi-110094, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Indira Gandhi ESIC Hospital, Jhilmil, Delhi-110095, in the treatment of complainant's

father Shri. Room Singh, resulting in his death, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

- (i) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3213 of Shri Bindeshwar Ram r/o-4/C, Shivalika Apartments, Plot No.16, Sector-09, Dwarka, New Delhi-110077, forwarded by the Office of the Dy. Commissioner of Police, Dwarka Distt, New Delhi, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Gunjan Verma of Manipal Hospital, Sector-06, Dwarka, New Delhi-110077, in the treatment of complainant's daughter Miss Neha Roy, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (j) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2956 of complaint of Smt. Sushma Malik, 13/9, West Patel Nagar, New Delhi-11000, alleging professional misconduct on the part of Dr. Vinod Mittal of Delhi Heart and Lung Institute, 3 MM-II, Punchkuian Road, New Delhi-110055, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (k) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.1791 of Shri Jai Narayan Das, r/- 405/33, Village jonti, Delhi-110081, forwarded by the Directorate of Health Services, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Brahm Shakti Hospital & Research Centre, Dr. Mukesh Orthopaedic & Trauma Centre and Saroj Super Specialty Hospital in the treatment administered to the complainant's son Shri Rohit at Brahm Shakti Hospital & Research Centre, U-1/78, Budh Vihar, Delhi-110086, Dr. Mukesh Orthopaedic & Trauma Centre, 2374-T (21A) Mandi Extn. Near Corporation Bank, Bawana Road, Narela, Delhi-110040 and Saroj Super Specialty Hospital, Madhuban Chowk Rohini, Delhi-110085, resulting in his death on 12.05.2015 at Saroj Super Specialty Hospital, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (1) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2487-an intimation No.31526 dated 11.06.2018 from the Abhishek Dev, IAS, District Magistrate, District South West, Kapashera, New Delhi-110037, as per which the charges have been framed under Section 23/25 of PC& PNDT Act, in the case of District Magistrate/District Appropriate Authority (PC-PNDT Act) Vs Dr. Angad Singh owner M/s Raj Lab, WZ-B, Bhagwati Garden, Dwarka More, Near Metro Pillar No.781, Uttam Nagar, New Delhi-110059, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of suspension of registration of Dr. Angad Singh (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.7527) from the State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council in terms of mandate under Section 23(2) PC & PNDT Act, till the criminal case against him is disposed-off.

- (m) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2139-a representation from Dy. Commissioner of Police North West District, seeking medical opinion in respect a death of Master Sunny @ Sahil s/o Shri Anil Kumar, allegedly due to medical negligence on the part of doctors of Babu Jagjivan Ram Hospital, Jahangir Puri, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (n) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2135 of Shri Vikas Chauhan s/o Shri Lokesh Chauhan r/o H.No.50, Near Billu General Store, Village Sungarpur, Bakhtawarpur, Delhi, forwarded by the Medical Council of India, alleging medical negligence in the preparation of HIV report, was confirmed by the Delhi Medial Council.
- (o) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No. 1937- a representation from Department of Health & Family, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, seeking request for review of the reports and Post-mortem report of the deceased Rajesh Goyal, to ascertain the possibility of any insufficiency of treatment and any kind of medical negligence on the part of doctors and staff of the Lok Nayak Hospital, was taken up for confirmation before the Delhi Medical Council.

Whilst confirming the decision of the Disciplinary Committee, the Council observed that the following observations mentioned at the Disciplinary Committee's Order be expunged, as the same are not warranted.

In view of the above, the Disciplinary Committee observes the following deficiencies in the management of the present case.

- (i) SOPs on the paper; not followed in letter and spirit.
- (ii) Critically injured patient was solely managed by the Junior Resident (Non-Academic) having limited training and experience for managing such patients.
- (iii) The patient (deceased) was shifted out of casualty for neurosurgery referral without being accompanied by healthcare personnel.

Further, the sentence mentioned in the Order of the Disciplinary Committee that "In view of the above observations, the committee makes the following recommendations:-" be expunged and substituted with "In view of the above, the committee makes the following recommendations:-" and also the following recommendations mentioned at point (iii) in the Order of the Disciplinary Committee be expunged, as the same is uncalled for

(iii) The patient should not be disposed/discharged by a doctor less than of a Senior Resident level.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

(p) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No. 2138 - a representation from Police Station Chhawla, Delhi, seeking medical opinion in death of Smt. Prema Devi w/o Ram Kripal Shukla, allegedly due to medical negligence in the treatment administered to her at Balaji Hospital and MSD Child Health CareVihar, Vikas Marg, Delhi-110092, resulting in her death on 11.5.2011 at GTB Hospital, was taken up for confirmation before the Delhi Medical Council.

Whilst confirming the Order of the Disciplinary Committee, the Council observed that in the facts and circumstances of this case, a copy of this Order be also sent to the Director General of Health Services, Govt. of NCT of Delhi for investigating the infrastructure available at Balaji Hospital for undertaking surgical procedures and practice of hiring operation theatre just for the purposes of surgery under anaesthesia.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of removal of name of Dr. Sanjay Kumar Shukla (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.25311) and Dr. Abhishek Maru (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.DMC/R/849) from the State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council for a period of 90 days awarded by the Disciplinary Committee.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 30 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

### 4. To discuss about the Minutes of the Anti Quackery Committee.

The Secretary informed that there are no minutes of the Anti-Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council on which discussion is required, as no meeting of the Anti-Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council had been convened.

### 5. To discuss about the Minutes of the Finance Committee.

The minutes of the meeting of the Finance Committee of the Delhi Medical Council held on 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 (appended herewith as annexure 'B') which were circulated to the members present, were confirmed.

## Conference Room, Delhi Medical Council.

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i) The Council observes that the some of the Registered Medical Practitioners of the Delhi Medical Council are misrepresenting their qualification/qualifications, even though, the same is/are not recognized qualification as per the Schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and infact claims themselves to be specialist viz. gynaecologist, sonologist, radiologist, etc. The Council further observes that making a claim of being a specialist without holding a recognized post-graduate qualification in any subject, is clear violation	Any other item with permission of Chair	To discuss about the Minutes of the Land & Building Committee. of Regulation 7.20 and 1.4.2 of the Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics), Regulations, 2002. The contents of which are reproduced herein-below, failing which they shall be liable for disciplinary action.

7.20- "A Physician shall not claim to be specialist unless he has a special qualification in that branch".

1.4.2- "Physicians shall display as suffix to their names only recognized medical degrees or such certificates/diplomas and memberships/honours which confer professional knowledge or recognizes any exemplary qualification/achievements."

The Council, therefore, directs that the Registered Medical Practitioners of the Delhi Medical Council should refrain themselves from the violation of the Regulations 7.20 and 1.4.2 of the Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics), Regulations, 2002.

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The Council observes that some of the Registered Medical Practitioners of the Delhi Medical Council who possess the qualification of M.D. "Physician", have been misrepresenting their qualification by suffixing 'M.D' to their names, as the abbreviation of 'M.D.' can only be used by a person who is a holder of post-graduate medical qualification. Further, the qualification with the nomenclature M.D.(Physician) awarded by various medical universities/institutes outside India is equivalent M.B.B.S. qualification in India. The Council further observes that misrepresenting the qualification without holding a recognized post-graduate qualification in any

subject, is clear violation of Regulation 7.20 and 1.4.2 of the Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics), Regulations, 2002. The contents of which are reproduced hereinbelow, failing which they shall be liable for disciplinary action.

7.20- "A Physician shall not claim to be specialist unless he has a special qualification in that branch".

1.4.2- "Physicians shall display as suffix to their names only recognized medical degrees or such certificates/diplomas and memberships/honours which confer professional knowledge or recognizes any exemplary qualification/achievements."

The Council, therefore, directs that the Registered Medical Practitioners of the Delhi Medical Council should adhere to the Regulations 7.20 and 1.4.2 of the Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics), Regulations, 2002. Further, the holders of M.D. (Physician) qualification awarded by various medical universities/institutes outside India should mention in their letter head prescription, certificates, money receipts given to patients, clinic boards, etc. as mention M.D. (physician) equivalent to M.B.B.S.

- Letter received from the Permanent Employees of the Council was placed before the Finance Committee of the Council, regarding request for granting Bonus for the F.Y. 2020-2021. Bonus was granted to the Permanent employees of the Delhi Medical Council @ 8.33% of their Annual Salary for the festive season of Deepawali to celebrate the festive season happily, every year. The Finance Committee Sanctioned bonus @ 8.33% of their annual salary to the 12 permanent employees of the council.
- F.D.R. which is due to be matured on 23/11/2021 with PNB Housing Finance Limited amounting to Rs. 4,65,10,416/- along-with another F.D.R which is due to be matured on 30/11/2021 with Syndicate Bank, MAMC amounting of Rs. 3,92,07,819/68 was placed before the Finance Committee of the council.
