## ORDER

In the present matter, the complainant has challenged the authenticity of MLC No. 225 dated 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2003 of Parmarth Mission Hospital, 23/7, Shakti Nagar, Delhi in respect of one Shri Tushar Aggarwal s/o. Shri Madan Mohan r/o. B-185B, Shastri Nagar, Delhi – 110052. It is alleged that Respondents 1 & 2 have manipulated the aforesaid MLC, thereby, committing professional misconduct.

It has been argued by the Respondents that the present proceeding has been the complainant to counterblast the criminal proceedings and MACT claim complainant is facing in the Courts of Law.
